# ORTHOINDY TRAUMA



Since 1993, Ortholndy has been training orthopedic traumatologists. The team, with a combined 119 years of experience, includes six fellowship trained traumatologists (staff has trained at Shock Trauma, Harborview, Johns Hopkins and Ortholndy Trauma). In the 26 years since our fellowship began, Ortholndy has trained 46 board certified surgeons who have gone on to practice in both academic and community settings across the country.

In an effort to create a comprehensive training experience, as a fellow, you will be exposed to management of a large volume of patients. The scope of practice will include acute poly trauma injuries, complex articular injuries, along with fragility fractures, peri-prosthetic fractures, malunions, nonunions and a very active reconstructive (total joint) and osteotomy experience. We have a weekly multi-disciplinary didactic conference. All patient care is under the direct guidance of our experienced staff surgeons.

- We've created a system that allows the fellow the flexibility to be available for a greater number of operative cases (>800 per year).
- We have built a team of very experienced mid-level practitioners who are primarily responsible
  for all ER and floor consults, daily rounds and clinic visits. This allows the fellow the freedom
  to focus on his/her education and operative skills that will be paramount in their practice
  post-fellowship.
- There is also time dedicated to research and study.







### **Ascension St. Vincent Trauma Center**

- Six Ascension St. Vincent StatFlight helicopter bases stationed around the state (largest air medical provider in Indiana)
- 840 bed facility, Level I Trauma Center
- In 2021, there were 46,855 patients seen in the ER
  - 4,397 trauma activations
  - 2,610 orthopedic admits/consults
  - 92% blunt trauma
  - 7% penetrating trauma
  - 1% burn

#### Level I Trauma Center

In 2012, we transitioned our entire trauma program to the Ascension St. Vincent Trauma Center. In 2016, the Ascension St. Vincent Trauma Center became a Level I facility. Since Ortholody Trauma personally had a hand in building the program, we have been able to draw on everyone's far reaching experience to create a trauma program that was described as "the best start up trauma program," according to the American College of Surgeons. In the past, we have trained anywhere between two and four fellows per year. We are consistently increasing our case volume with the maximum number of cases by a fellow being 1,216 to date. Ortholody Trauma, along with Ascension St. Vincent, has served as an AOTrauma Fellowship Host Center hosting fellows from around the world. We hope these resources are consistent with the style of learning you are seeking.
