

# Ben McAfee, PT

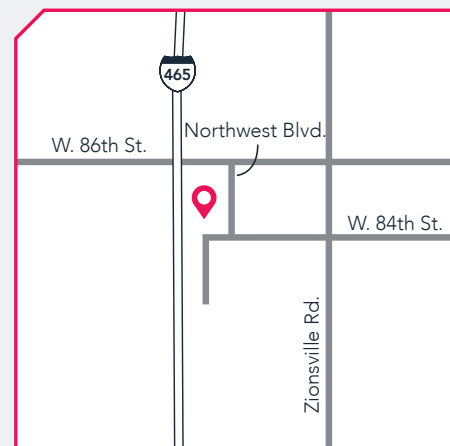
Physical Therapist



Ben McAfee serves in inpatient orthopedic care, with a particular interest in helping patients recover from hip and knee replacement procedures. He works with patients in the earliest stages of recovery, often the same day as their surgery, helping them safely regain mobility and build confidence before returning home or transitioning to a rehabilitation setting.

What sets Ben apart is his patient, attentive approach. He takes time to listen carefully and encourages questions, ensuring each patient feels heard and supported throughout the start of their recovery process. He also collaborates closely with orthopedic surgeons, physician assistants and nurse practitioners when needed to support seamless communication and continuity of care.

Ben was first drawn to physical therapy as a high school athlete, after receiving treatment for a shoulder injury and shin splints. He graduated from Indiana University with a bachelor's degree in physical therapy. While he initially envisioned working with athletes, he later turned to inpatient care and the opportunity to make a meaningful impact during a critical window in a patient's recovery. For Ben, success means helping patients meet their mobility goals so they can return home safely, move independently and reduce their risk of falling.
